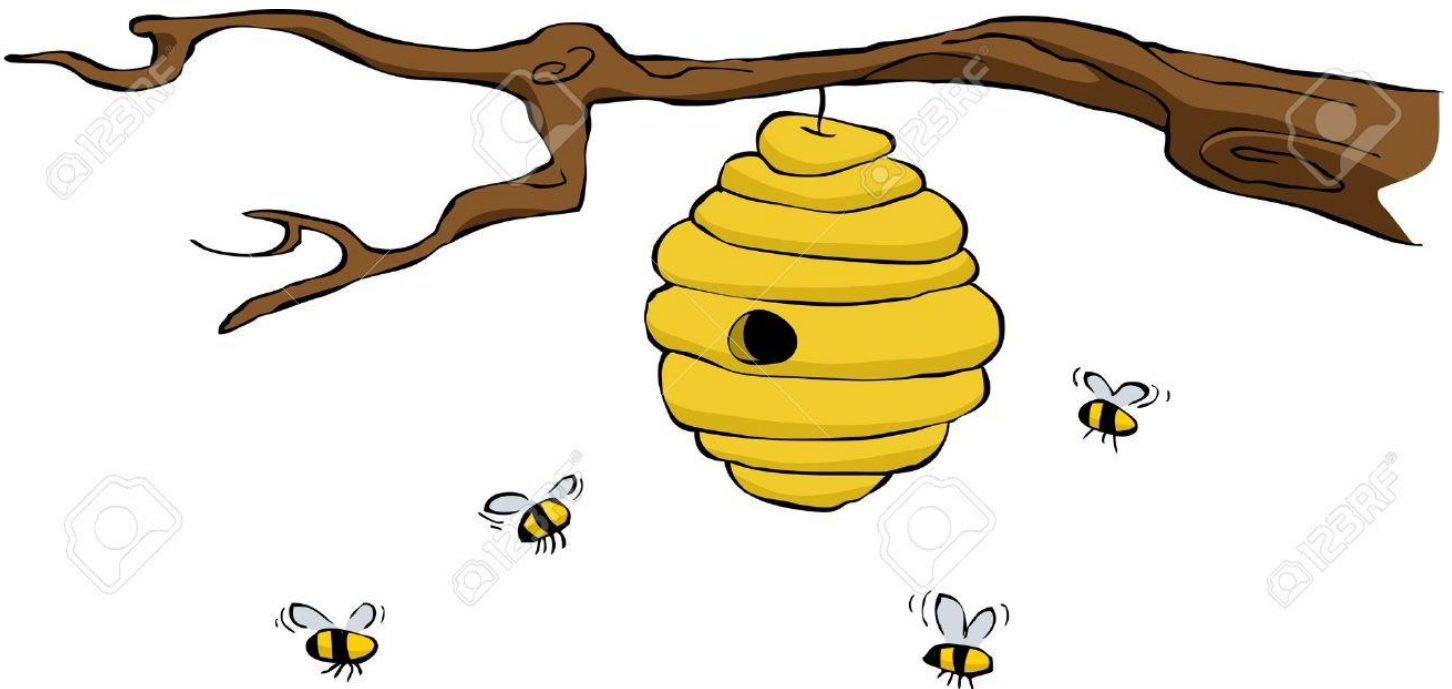

Most Improved Club

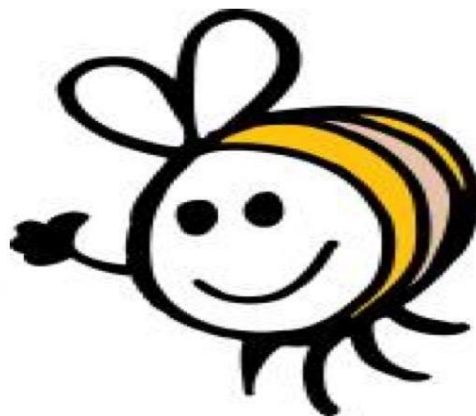
